

Parental Permission to Apply External Preparations

With the exception of first aid, staff shall not dispense prescription or non-prescription medications to a child without written authorization from the child's physician or parent. Such authorization will include, when applicable, full name of child, date, name of medication, prescription number, if any; dosage, the dates given, the time of day to be dispensed, and signature of parent.
